Danish children's acquisition of inflectional morphology

- the development of noun plural inflection in the age of 0-10 years

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This study investigates the development of the noun plural inflectional category in Danish children from the first appearance up to the age of 10 years. It is based on a multi-method research approach in order to get a fuller picture of Danish children's acquisition of noun plurals. The study rests on a sound-based analysis of the Danish noun plural system, and investigates the hypothesis that the productivity of the plural markers has an impact on acquisition. In order to test the hypothesis, a scale with three degrees of productive; and 3) *unproductive*. The acquisition rate is predicted to go from *fully productive* to *semi-productive* to *unproductive* plural markers and the error direction to go from *unproductive* to *semi-productive* to *fully productive* to *fully productive* plural markers. These predictions are confirmed by the study.
